

# Prepositions of Spatial Relationships

The following table is a list of prepositions used to indicate spatial relationships:

<b>Above</b>	Write your name <b>above</b> the line.
<b>Across</b>	Draw a line <b>across</b> the page.
<b>Against</b>	She leans <b>against</b> the tree.
<b>Ahead of</b>	The girl is <b>ahead of</b> the boy.
<b>Along</b>	There is lace <b>along</b> the edge of the cloth.
<b>Among</b>	He is <b>among</b> the trees.
<b>Around</b>	Draw a circle <b>around</b> the answer.
<b>Behind</b>	The girl is <b>behind</b> the boy.
<b>Below</b>	Write your name <b>below</b> the line.
<b>Beneath</b>	He is <b>beneath</b> the tree.
<b>Beside</b>	The girl is <b>beside</b> the boy.
<b>Between</b>	She is <b>between</b> the trees.
<b>From</b>	He came <b>from</b> the house.
<b>In Front of</b>	The girl is <b>in front of</b> the boy.
<b>Inside</b>	He is <b>inside</b> the house.
<b>Nearby</b>	The tree is <b>nearby</b> the house.
<b>Off</b>	His hat is <b>off</b> .
<b>Out of</b>	He came <b>out of</b> the house.
<b>Through</b>	She went <b>through</b> the door.
<b>Toward</b>	She is walking <b>toward</b> the house.
<b>Under</b>	He is hiding <b>under</b> the table.
<b>Within</b>	Please mark only <b>within</b> the circle.
